Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship from the Monterey Bay Blues Festival. The following will assist you in preparing your scholarship application. Please follow directions carefully and submit your application on or before the deadline, April 15, 2010.

New this year is a checklist for your convenience which will recap what is required to complete your application. It must be signed and returned with your application.

Purpose: The purpose of MBBF Scholarships is to encourage, promote and support students. This is a non-music academic scholarship given in honor of Mel Grimes, Esq., a former director of the Monterey Bay Blues Festival who is now deceased.

Scholarships: Due to the present economic situation, scholarships are only available to graduating high school students and college students. Once awards are announced, applicants may not change their funding objectives.

Eligibility: Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen. A copy of the applicant's birth certificate or naturalization papers is required.

Students must not be older than 21 years of age at the time of selection.

Selections are in late April 2010.

Students must have a **Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher pursuing a higher education degree.**

This is an non-music academic scholarship.

Employees and volunteers of MBBF or family members of MBBF Board members are eligible to apply however, the known or related board member may not participate in the selection process.

Applications: Applications should be typed or written in ink.

Notification: The applicant will be notified by mail no later than April 30, 2010.

Awards: The Mel Grimes award will be given at the annual COSO celebration in June and the recipient is **expected** to attend or have a parent, sibling, etc., represent them. The Mel Grimes scholarship is a non-music award. Awards may also be made at the recipient's school awards night.
